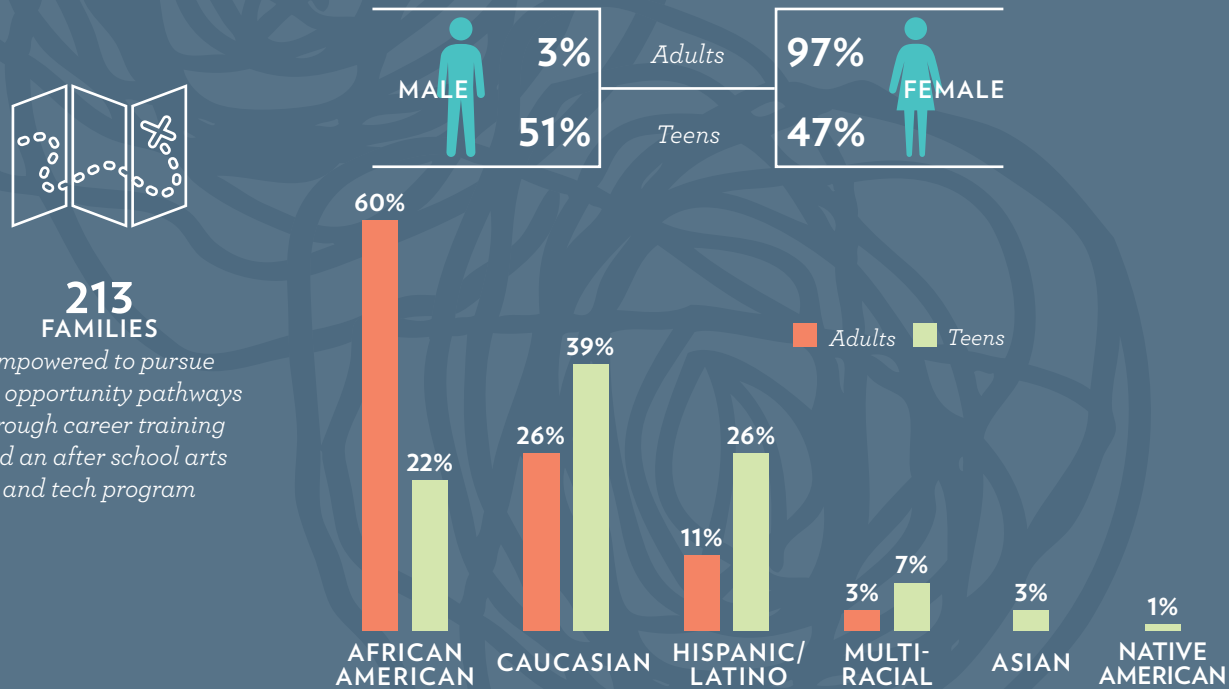

The West Michigan Center for Arts + Technology provides a culture of opportunity for people to make social and economic progress in their lives and community.

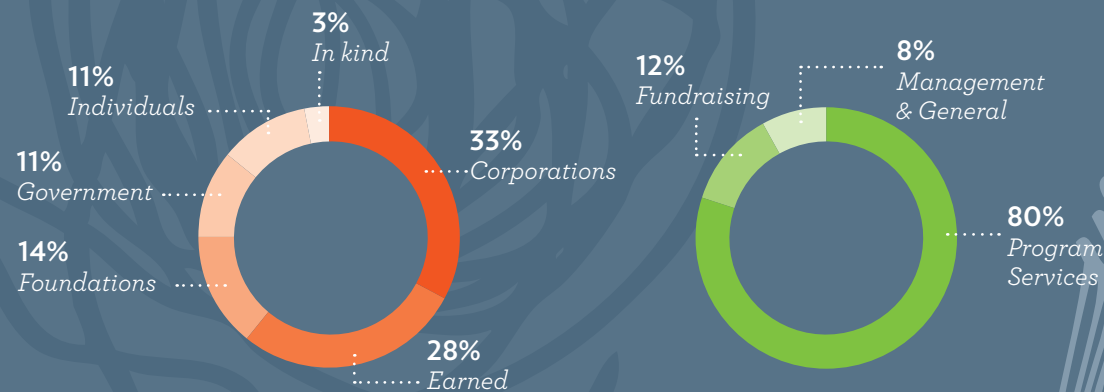

WORKFORCE DEVELOPMENT

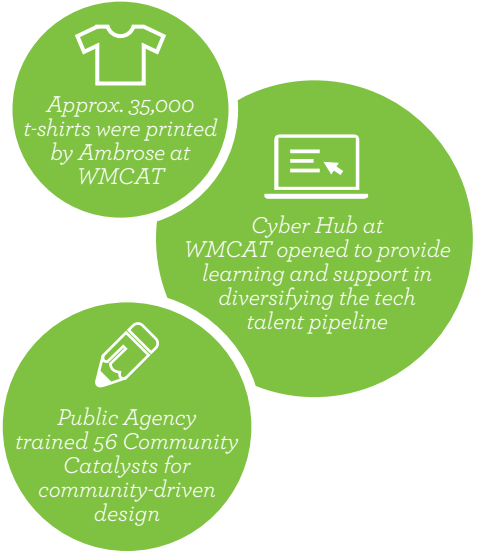
Committed to building income security for families, centering learning and engagement on their lived experiences

Committed to making space for young people to wrestle with complex issues and share their unique perspectives through art-making

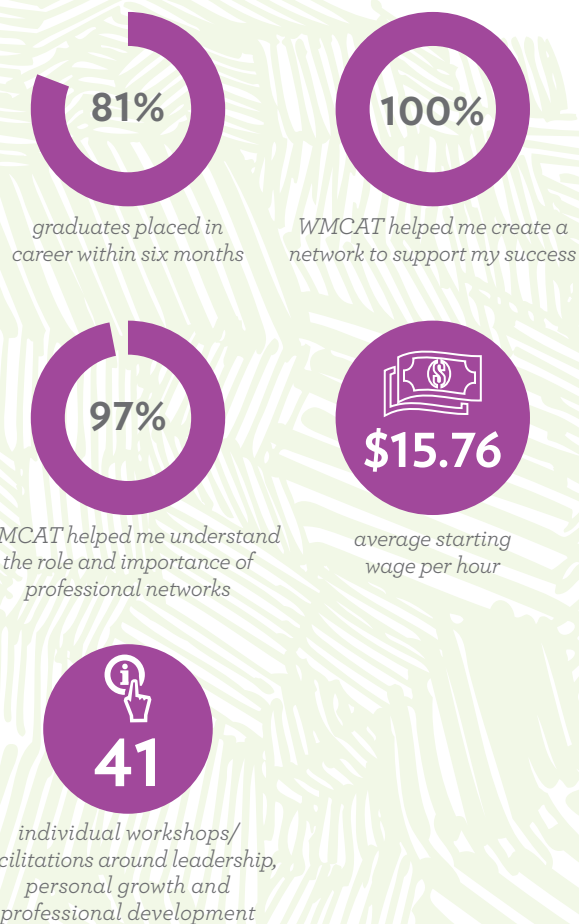
Tuition-free after school program for Grand Rapids Public high school students in visual and media arts

Daytime studios for area middle and high school classrooms that connect learning to creativity

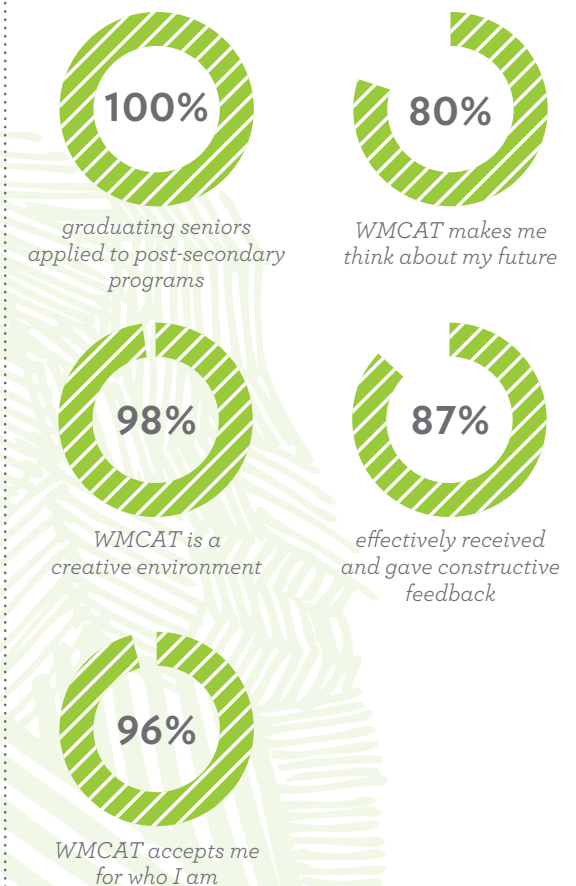
Summer engagement through camps and an employment experience in creative placemaking
